We would like to invite you to attend our Year 7 Parents' Evening on Thursday 29 January.

As with all our parents' evenings, we would like to meet with yourself and your child at the appointment, and your child should attend in full school uniform.

This parents evening is an opportunity to meet with subject teachers and tutors to discuss your child's current attainment and what actions to take to maximise their progress.

The Parents' Evening will take place in our Sports Hall which is located on the left of the school as you enter from the main entrance. Upon arrival you will receive a copy of their most recent tracker which shows current grades for all subjects and other key information.

As well as meeting with your child's teachers there will also be an opportunity for you and your child to meet with external agencies including college and further education representatives. Members of the Senior Leadership Team will also be present if you have any issues that you wish to discuss.

Appointments will be approximately 5 minutes long.

Your child will be provided with a booking sheet by their form teacher. Each student will ask each of their teachers for an appointment time and then record it on the sheet.

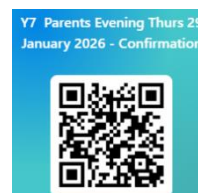
Please discuss with your child what times you want and then check that the timings that your child has booked are sensible for you.
