## Year 11 Parents' Evening - Thursday 12 March 3:45pm-6:15pm

We would like to invite you to attend our Year 11 Parents' Evening on Thursday 12 March. As with our usual parents' evenings, we would like to meet with yourself and your child at the appointment, and your child should attend in full school uniform.

This is a final opportunity for you and your child to meet subject teachers in order to review their progress and to discuss what steps to take to gain the highest grades possible for their final GCSE exams and coursework.

As part of the evening you will receive a booklet of key information including the most recent tracker, Mock examination results, how to work with us to support your child, a provisional examination timetable and post-16 guidance.

There will also be a range of external agency and careers information and the opportunity to meet with members of the Senior Leadership Team.

When arriving at the Academy, please head towards the Sports Hall entrance located on the left-hand side of school site as arriving from Dent Street.

You will be sent a separate link to a simple Microsoft Form which you can click on to indicate whether you can attend or/and if you require any further information.
